

# Sewage Compliance Form Instructions

- 1) Acquire a Sewage Compliance Form from the Codes and Permitting Office located in City Hall, Room 200, 401 Main St., Johnstown, PA.
- 2) The owner of the property applying for sewage compliance certification must fill out the top part of the front page.
- 3) A licensed City of Johnstown contractor, having a master plumber on staff, is required to fill out the bottom part of the front page and the top of the back page (drawing). The registered master plumber or a journeyman plumber working under the master plumber may sign off on the contractor's part.
- 4) If the owner's section and the contractor's section are completed and there was no problem or all problems were corrected, return the form to the Codes and Permitting Office with a check for \$25. (Payable to the "City of Johnstown")
- 5) If everything is correct the certificate will be issued within 10 days.

**Note:** If there is a problem which cannot be corrected right away, then a temporary certificate can be applied for. To do this you fill out the temporary certificate section on the middle of the back page and return the form to the Codes and Permitting Office. You will then be contacted if it was approved or denied.
